

St. Patrick School Chromebook Agreement

Providing Chromebooks for use by our students is an exciting adventure. Certain guidelines are necessary to protect the Chromebooks and ensure that this technology serves as an effective instructional tool.

Students and their parents/guardians must agree to the following:

1. The student shall not remove or alter any labels attached to or displayed on the Chromebook.
2. The student agrees to handle the Chromebook carefully and protect it from potential sources of damage.
3. The Chromebook is the property of St. Patrick School. If a student withdraws from the school prior to the end of the school year, the Chromebook is to be returned to school officials by the student prior to withdrawal.
4. So that we do not experience technical issues with the Chromebook, we ask that you do not attempt to download any information to the Chromebook. Any attempt to download other apps onto the Chromebook will result in that student being unable to use the Chromebook in the future. Also, any attempt to “reset” the Chromebook and create a new account will result in that student being unable to use the Chromebook in the future.
5. The student agrees to take care of and to keep the Chromebook safe and secure. The student will assume the same risk of loss by theft, destruction or damage as with any textbook. The student will be responsible for the replacement of any Chromebook that is lost, stolen or damaged.

My child and I have read and agree to comply with these guidelines.
